

Project Status Glossary

The project *status field* communicates a high-level view on project progress. There are 8 different values that can be specified to describe the current state of the project, specifically:

1. Draft – The project is not ready to proceed as some elements such as the environmental impact statement or the project scope are still to be finalized.
2. Ready – All necessary preparatory work is completed, and the project is ready to implement.
3. Design – Agency personnel are performing the design work necessary for on-the-ground implementation work. If design work and implementation are ongoing simultaneously then the project status will display as *Work in Progress*.
4. Contract Awarded – A contract(s) and/or agreement(s) to implement the work has been awarded. If contract awards and on-the-ground implementation work are occurring simultaneously the project status field will display as *Work in Progress*.
5. Work in Progress – Actual on-the-ground work related to the project is in progress.
6. Completed – All elements of project have been completed.
7. Suspended – The project is temporarily on hold due to unforeseen circumstances.
8. Terminated – The project is no longer viable and is canceled.
